M/L 60 cm head circumference

## Skill Level

Easy

# Materials

Yarn :Borgo de'Pazzi Firenze- Artilea 2 balls (100 grams)

# **Knitting Needles:**

5mm double pointed needles 6.5mm double pointed needles

#### Stitch markers

# Gauge

12sts x 16 rows= 10x10cm on 6.5mm needles 14 sts x20 rows= 10x10cm on 5mm needles

# Notes

This hat is knitted in the round, starting from the bottom with 2x2 rib. The hat is the continued in stocking stitch, ending with 8 rows of decreasing.

Pattern is written with the smallest size first, with the larger size to follow.

## Stitches

K= knit

P=purl

dec= decrease (knit two stitches together)

2x2 rib= Knit 2, Purl 2

## Artilea Hat

Using your 6.5mm needles, loosely cast on 56+1 stitches/60+1 stitches. Slip the extra stitch onto the right hand needle and place a marker. Knit the extra stitch and the first stitch together. This will avoid a jog at your join.

Continue knitting in 2x2 ribbing for 14/16 rows.

Change to 5mm needles, continue to knit in stocking stitch (knit all rows) for 18/20 rows.

Decreasing- Knit 1 more row, placing 1 stitch marker every 14/15 stitches.

Knit 8 rows, decreasing 1 st after each stitch marker on each round.

Cut the yarn (approximately 20 cm in length) and pass through all stitches with a sewing needle.

Apply a pompom to the top.

Weave in all ends.

Pom-Pom- Wrap your yarn around your hand approximately 20 times. Slip the wrapped yarn off of your hand, and tie it in the middle with a knot. Cut the yarn in the middle at either end of the knot, and fluff it up to create your pompom. Trim if desired.
