## Hooded Scarf

Designed by Elizabeth Fallone

### Materials:

4 100 gram balls Estelle Drake  
8 mm needles

Pockets: make 2

Cast on 20 stitches

Row 1: knit

Row 2: purl

Repeat the last 2 rows 10 more times a total of 22 rows.

Row 23: k1, \*p2, k2\* repeat to last 3 stitches p2, k1

Row 24: p1, \*k2, p2\* repeat to last 3 stitches k2, p1

Repeat last two rows once more.

Cast off in pattern.

### Scarf:

Cast on 36 stitches

Rows 1 – 4: knit 2, purl 2

Rows 5 – 8: purl 2, knit 2

Repeat these 8 rows until scarf is desired length or enough yarn remains to cast off.

Fold scarf in half length wise and sew 8 to 10" down from fold to form a hood.

Sew pockets to bottom of scarf or your desired spot.
