**Coffee Cup Cozy in Estelle Alcazar**  
**Designed by Kate Atherley for Estelle Yarns**

**Difficulty Level:** Beginner

**Sizes & Finished measurements:**

One size

Approximately 8 inches circumference, 3.5 inches wide – stretches to fit any disposable coffee cup.

**Materials:**

1 ball (about 100 grams) Estelle Yarns “Alcazar”

1 pair 6mm needles

A spare double-pointed or short circular needle, size 3.5-5mm. Size of needle isn't critical, but it should be smaller than the ones you're working with.

**Gauge:**

Approximately 14 sts and 20 rows = 4 inches.

**Method :**

Cast on 11 sts.

Pattern row: K1, (p1, k1) to end of round.

Repeat Pattern row until piece measures 8 inches from cast-on edge. Leave these stitches on the needle.

Use spare needle to pick up 11 loops from the cast on edge.

**Finishing**

Turn work so that WS is facing, and fold the piece in half, holding the needles hold the stitches parallel, together.

Using the 6mm needle to work the sts, knit together the first st from the front and back needles. \*Knit together the next st from the front and back needles. 2 sts on right needle. Lift the first st over the second and let it drop off. Rep from \* until a final st remains on the right needle. Cut yarn and pull through final st to secure.

Wash and weave in ends.
