

FREE PATTERN





**Spiral Cowl in Estelle Alcazar**  
**Designed by Kate Atherley for Estelle Yarns**

**Difficulty Level:**

Easy – knitters need to know how to knit in the round.

**Sizes & Finished measurements:**

One size

Approximately 48 inches circumference, 8 inches deep

**Materials:**

2 balls (about 200 grams) Estelle Yarns “Alcazar”

1 24 inch 8mm circular needles

A single knitting needle, size 10-12mm, for casting off

**Gauge:**

Approximately 13 sts and 20 rounds = 4 inches square in spiral rib pattern, after washing. Gauge is not critical for this project.

**Method:**

Cast on 113 stitches. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist. A marker is not required.

Work [k3, p3] around, until piece measures approximately 8 inches, or desired width.

*Note: the ribbing pattern spirals because of the number of stitches. If you want to change the size of the piece, make sure you're casting on a multiple of 6 stitches less 1.*

Using the larger needle in your right hand to work the stitches, cast off.

**Finishing:**

Wash and weave in ends.
