



FREE PATTERN





Spiral Headband in Estelle Alcazar

Difficulty Level:

Easy – knitters need to know how to knit in the round.

Sizes & Finished measurements:

Teen/Women's Small (Adult Medium, Adult Large)

Circumference: 16 (18, 20) inches – piece should measure 3-4 inches smaller than head circumference

Depth: 4 inches

Materials:

1 ball (about 100 grams) Estelle Yarns “Alcazar”

1 16 inch 6mm circular needles

A single knitting needle, size 10-12mm, for casting off

Gauge:

Approximately 14 sts and 20 rounds = 4 inches square in spiral rib pattern, after washing.

Gauge is not critical for this project.

Method:

Cast on 47 (53, 59) stitches. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist. A marker is not required.

Work [k3, p3] around, until piece measures approximately 4 inches, or desired width.

Note: the ribbing pattern spirals because of the number of stitches. If you want to change the size of the piece, make sure you're casting on a multiple of 6 stitches less 1.

Using the larger needle in your right hand to work the stitches, cast off.

Finishing:

Wash and weave in ends.

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
