

FREE PATTERN



ESTELLE Super Alpaca 60 Lacy Cowl Designed by Kate Atherley

Difficulty Level: Advanced beginner – knitters must have experience knitting in the round. Easy lace is unexpected and effective at a larger scale.

Sizes & Finished measurements: Small (Large) Circumference: 20 (40) inches – snug neck warmer, or a double wrap, Depth: 8 (7) inches

Materials:

1 (2) skeins Estelle Yarns “Alpaca 60” (100% superfine Alpaca; 60m/100g)

For small: 1 16 inch 8mm circular needle

For large: 1 32 inch 8mm circular needle

For both: stitch marker, spare 10-12mm needle for casting off

Gauge:

Approximately 8 sts and 14 rounds = 4 inches square in lace pattern stitch

Approximately 10 sts = 4 inches in stocking stitch

Method:

CO 39 (81) sts. Place marker and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist.

Pattern round 1: (K2tog, yo, k1) around.

Pattern round 2: Purl.

Work the pattern as set until you’re almost out of yarn, ending with pattern round 1. (You need about 4 times the length of the round to cast off. For the smaller size, you can get about 17 openwork pattern rounds; for the larger size, 15.)

Using the larger needle to work the stitches, cast off purlwise.

Finishing:

Wash and weave in ends.
