Alpaca 60 Easy Fashionable Cowl

Create an easy-to-wear and fashionable accessory!

Difficulty Level: Easy – knitters need to know how to knit in the round.

Sizes & Finished Measurements: One size.

Approximately 40 inches/100cm in circumference, 7 inches/17.5cm deep

Materials: 2 skeins Estelle Yarns “Alpaca 60” (100% superfine alpaca; 60m/100gm skein); (shown in col 305)

Needles: One 24 inch 8mm circular needle
1 knitting needle, size 10-12mm, for casting off

Gauge: For Alpaca 60: Approximately 8 sts and 21 rounds = 4 inches square in seed st pattern on 8mm needles, after washing.
Gauge is not critical for this project, although the finished size of the project may vary.

Method:

Cast on 79 sts. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist. A stitch marker is not required.

Work [k1, p1] around, until you've just about run out of yarn. Leave yourself about 5yds/5m of yarn for casting off.

Note: Because you have an odd number of stitches, the seed stitch works out without counting or planning.

Using the larger needle in your right hand to work the stitches, cast off in pattern.

Finishing:

Wash and weave in ends.
