

FREE PATTERN

ESTELLE YARNS
COMET PONCHO

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Estelle Comet Poncho

Difficulty Level: Advanced Beginner

Size and Finished Measurements:

One size, to fit the average adult.

Approximately 48" circumference by 16" deep

Materials:

4 100g/70m Estelle Yarns "Comet" – col 001

1 24" 10mm/US size 15 circular needle

1 16" 8mm/US size 11 circular needle

1 stitch marker

darning needle

Gauge: 10 sts x 12 rows = 4 ins/10 cm with 10mm/US size 15 needles

Method:

With 10mm needle, cast on 18 sts.

Work back and forth on needle as follows:

Row 1 (RS): (K2, P2) to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2 (WS): (P2, K2) to last 2 sts, P2.

Rep rows 1 and 2 until work from beg measures approx. 48", ending with Row 2.

Cast off all sts and break yarn, leaving an approx. 36" tail for seaming.

Seam cast on and cast off edges together, being sure not to twist work.

With right side of knitted loop facing, pick up and knit 110 sts evenly around entire top edge of loop. (Hint: Aim to pick up 9 sts for every 4 inches, adding 2 extra sts at the end) PM and join for knitting in the round.

Knit 6 rounds.

Next: (K8, K2tog) to end of round (99 sts).

Knit 3 rounds.

Next: (K7, K2tog) to end of round. (88 sts).

Knit 3 rounds.

Next: (K6, K2tog) to end of round (77 sts).

Knit 3 rounds.

Next: (K5, K2tog) to end of round (66 sts).

Knit 3 rounds.

Next: (K4, K2tog) to end of round (55 sts).

Collar:

Next round: change to 8mm needle, K2tog, P1, (K1,P1) to end of round (54 sts).

Next: (K1, P1) to end of round.

Rep from * to * for 3".

Cast off in (K1, P1) rib.

Weave in all ends.
