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Constellation Shawl - Garter stitch short rows with eyelets

Designed by Shannon Charles for Estelle Yarns

This shawl is knit in garter stitch using short rows in each wedge to give it a curved swirl effect. The finished product is a fun shape with added eyelet cluster detail with many ways to wear and make your own.

Materials: Estelle Alpaca Merino Chunky or Estelle Chunky - 4 skeins, 6.0mm 24" circular needles

Pattern: This shawl is knit using short rows, it is worked by stopping 3st before last turn and simply turning the work and knitting back the opposite way.

Using 6mm circular needle cast on 72st and knit 1 WS row.

Wedge Pattern: RS knit to last 3 st, move yarn to the front and turn work. WS knit to end of row.

RS knit to 3st before last turn, move yarn to front, turn to work WS, knit to end of row.

Continue to work wedge in pattern noted above until you have worked all 72st into short rows ending with WS row.

•Closing Short Row Gaps: RS Knit to the gap created by short rows, with left needle, pick up garter stitch bump under the live stitch on the right needle and knit picked up bump and first stitch after the gap together (k2tog).

Continue to close short row gaps as noted.

•Making Eyelets: WS K2, **yo, k2tog** (knit 2, yarn over, knit 2 together) continue from ** to **until end of row. Knit RS row.

WS: Cast off 15st, knit to end of row 57st. Using cable cast on method cast on 15st. (should have total 72st)

Follow wedge pattern as noted to create 7 additional wedges.

8th Wedge: After creating eyelets on WS knit 1 RS row to complete eyelet pattern. WS cast off all 72 st loosely. weave in all ends and block to finish.
