MULTI-PURPOSE SCARF
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FREE PATTERN



Drake Garter Stitch Multi-Purpose Scarf

Difficulty Level: Beginner

Size and Finished Measurements:

One size. May be worn as a regular scarf; joined and buttoned up as an infinity scarf with the option to wrap around the neck up to three times; or wrapped around the head, buttoned in place and wound around neck as a cozy hooded scarf.
Approximately 10" wide by 60" long.

Materials: 2 skeins (100g/100m) Estelle Yarns "Drake" (shown in col 459)

4 buttons with a maximum diameter of 1", or toggle-style
Small amount of light-weight yarn or embroidery thread in a colour that matches the yarn used for sewing on buttons

Needles: 1 pair 10mm needles (US 15)

Gauge: 8 sts x 12 rows = 4 ins/10 cm in garter st (knit every row)

Stitch Glossary: *sl 1st st purlwise*, *yb* – insert right needle from right to left in front of first stitch as if to purl and slip the stitch onto the right needle without working it. Allow this stitch to remain loose. Bring the yarn between the needles to the back of the work in preparation for knitting the next stitch.

Method:

Cast on 20 sts

Row 1: *sl 1st st purlwise*, *yb*, K to end

Rep row 1 until work from beg measures 60"

Cast off loosely in knit (do not slip first stitch)

Finishing:

Weave in ends. Sew on buttons approximately 2" from cast on edge, with the first and last buttons placed approximately 1 ½" from the side edges and spacing the remaining 2 buttons evenly between these.
