# Estelle Eco Andean DK Brocade Wrap

**Difficulty Level:** Easy – knitters need to know how to knit and purl

**Sizes & Finished Measurements:** One size.

Approximately 14" wide by 57" long (unblocked), 64-66" (blocked)

**Materials:** 2 (100g/350m) Estelle Yarns "Eco Andean DK"

**Needles:** 1 pair 4.5mm needles (US 7)

Crochet hook to apply fringe (size is not crucial)

**Gauge:** 20 sts x 32 rows = 4 ins/10 cm in pattern

## Method:

Cast on 71 sts, leaving an 8" tail.

Row 1: K1, (P1, K7, P1, K1) to end.

Row 2: \*(K1, P1) twice, P4, K1, P1; rep from \* to last st, K1.

Row 3: K1, \*(P1, K1) twice, K2, (P1, K1) twice; rep from \* to end.

Row 4: \*P2, (K1, P1) 4 times; rep from \* to last st, P1.

Row 5: K1, \*K2, (P1, K1) 3 times, K2; rep from \* to end.

Row 6: (P4, K1, P1, K1, P3) to last st, P1.

Row 7: as row 5.

Row 8: as row 4.

Row 9: as row 3.

Row 10: as row 2.

Rep rows 1 to 10 until work from beg measures approx. 57", ending with row 1.

You should have enough yarn to do 47 reps of the 10-row pattern and still have enough left over for the fringe.

Cast off all sts knitwise and break yarn, leaving an 8" tail.

## Finishing:

Block lightly, pinning to shape on blocking board. Piece can be stretched to a length of approx. 64-66" while still maintaining 14" width. When dry, apply fringe as follows: Cut a piece of stiff cardboard that measures 8" square. Wrap yarn around cardboard 48 times, break yarn at same edge as starting yarn end and cut all the way across this edge (you will have 48 pieces of fringe, folded in half) Separate these strands into 16 sections of three strands each – 8 sections for each side). Working from the WS of work, insert crochet hook from back to front at one corner of the cast on edge of the wrap. Catch middle of first 3-strand fringe section on hook and pull through to back (WS) of wrap. Draw all 6 strands through loop and tighten. Repeat across edge, placing the next 6 fringe sections at the point where the lower tip of the brocade diamond meets the edge. Place 8th fringe section at other corner. Repeat for cast off edge. Be sure to incorporate the cast on and cast off tails into fringe sections as they appear. Trim fringe to even strands where necessary.
