

**Earflap Hat & Scarf Set**

**SCARF**

Sizes: one size

Finished measurements: Width: 6 inches  
Length: approximately 60"

**Materials:**

MC: 1 200gm skein Estelle Woolly Bully

CC: 1 200gm skein Estelle Woolly Bully

Needles: 10mm straight needles

Gauge: Approximately 14 sts in K2 P2 ribbing on 10mm needles = 4"/10cm

**Scarf:**

Using MC, cast on 20 stitches.

Work 2 rows K2 P2 ribbing as follows:

Ribbing row: \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Join CC yarn, and work 2 rows K2 P2 ribbing.

Change to MC yarn, and work 2 rows K2 P2 ribbing.

Continue as established, changing colours every 2 rows. Work until scarf measures approximately 60", ending with a MC stripe.

Cast off loosely in ribbing pattern with MC. Weave in all ends.

**HAT**

Sizes: Adult Small, Adult Large

Finished measurements: Circumference: 20 (22) inches. Hat will stretch to fit.

**Materials:**

MC: 1 200gm skein Estelle Woolly Bully

CC: 1 200gm skein Estelle Woolly Bully

Needles: 10mm straight needles

Gauge: 9 sts in Stocking Stitch on 10mm needles = 4"/10cm

**Hat:**

Directions given are for smaller size, with numbers for larger size in parentheses. When only one number appears, it applies to both sizes.

With MC, cast on 39 (41) sts.

Ribbing row 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Ribbing row 2: \*P1, k1; rep from \* to last st, p1.

Repeat last two rows once more.

Join CC. Next row (RS): K 6 (7), [kfb, k12] twice, kfb, k to end. 42 (44) sts.

Following row (WS): Purl.

Change to MC, and work 2 rows in Stocking Stitch.

Change to CC, and work 2 rows in Stocking Stitch.

Continue in Stocking Stitch in stripe pattern as established until piece measures 5 (5.5)" from cast-on edge.

Continuing in stripe pattern, changing yarns every two rows, dec for crown as follows:

Crown row 1: \*K2tog, k2; rep from \*. For smaller size only: k2tog at end of row. 31 (33) sts.

Crown row 2: Purl all sts.

Crown row 3: \*K2tog, k1; rep from \*. For smaller size only: k last st. 21 (22) sts.

Crown row 4: Purl all sts.

Crown row 5: K2tog across row. For smaller size only: knit last st. 11 sts.

Crown row 6: Purl all sts.

Crown row 7: K2tog to last st, k1. 6 sts.

Crown row 8: Purl all sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Draw through rem sts and pull to close. Using the tail, sew side seam.

**Earflaps:**

Hold hat so that RS is facing, with cast-on edge up. Measure 4.5" left from the seam. Starting at that point, with CC, pick up &amp;

knit 7 sts along cast-on edge.

Starting with a WS row, work 3 rows Stocking Stitch.

Dec row 1: SSK, k3, k2tog.

Dec row 2: Purl.

Dec row 3: SSK, k1, k2tog.

Dec row 4: Purl.

Final row: S2kpo.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail, and pull through final stitch. Cut another 24" length of CC yarn. Thread this through lower edge of earflap beside the tail that's already there, pulling it so that you've got three equal lengths of the yarn. Braid them together, and then tie an overhand knot about an inch from the end.

To position second earflap, measure 7" to the right of the seam, and work as for first. Weave in all ends.
