



FREE PATTERN



“The Ups and Down of Ribbing” Gladstone Scarf

Designed by Helen Firing

Difficulty Level: Easy – knitters need to know how to knit and purl.

Sizes & Finished measurements: One size.

Approximately 9 ½” wide by 72” long

Materials: 3 hanks (100g/160m) Estelle Yarns “Gladstone” (shown in col 421)

Needles: 1 pair 6mm (US 10) needles

Gauge: 15 sts x 21 rows = 4 ins/10 cm in st st with 6mm needles

Method:

Cast on 54 sts.

Row 1: P2, K2, P2, K3, P2, K4, P2, K5, P2, K6, P2, K5, P2, K4, P2, K3, P2, K2, P2.

Row 2: K2, P2, K2, P3, K2, P4, K2, P5, K2, P6, K2, P5, K2, P4, K2, P3, K2, P2, K2.

Rep rows 1 and 2 until work from beginning measures approx. 72” and/or you have at least 2 ½ yards of yarn remaining for casting off, ending with row 2.

Finishing:

Cast off in pattern.
