



FREE PATTERN

Difficulty Level: Advanced Beginner – knitters should be familiar with basic knitting skills and simple lace techniques

Finished Measurements: approximately 62” wingspan, 15” deep

Materials: 1 100g/400m ball SockItToMe Rolling Rock by Estelle or other SockItToMe yarn from Estelle

40” 3mm/US size 2 circular needle or size to obtain gauge, yarn needle, 2 stitch markers

Gauge: 28 sts and 36 rows = 4” in stocking stitch on 3mm/US size 2 needles

Method: Cast on 3 sts. K 6 rows.

Turn work 90 degrees, pick up and knit 3 sts along side of tab, turn work 90 degrees, pick up and knit 3 sts along cast on edge. (9 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K3, YO, K1, YO, PM, K1, PM, YO, K1, YO, K3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, YO, P to last 3 sts, YO, K3.

Row 3 (RS): K3, YO, K to st before next m, kf&b, slm, K1, slm, kf&b, K to last 3 sts, YO, K3.

Rep rows 2 and 3 to 235 sts. Depth of shawl will be approx. 9 1/2”.

*Next row (WS): K3, YO, K to st before marker, P1, slm, P1, slm, K to last 3 sts, YO, K3.

Next row: (RS): K3, YO, K to last 3 sts, YO, K3. (4 sts increased)

Rep these 2 rows once more. (243 sts)

Rep rows 2 and 3 as above 3 times (261 sts. Depth of shawl will be approx. 10 1/2”)*

Rep from * to * 3 times more (339 sts, approx. depth 14”)

Next row (WS): K3, YO, K to last 3 sts, YO, K3.

Rep this row 10 times. (361 sts)

Cast off loosely.

Finishing:

Weave in ends and block, pinning shawl to finished measurements as indicated above.

Finished shawl should be somewhat “U-shaped”, with long edges arcing upward. Bottom wedge should be blocked as a curve, not a point.
