MERLIN

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Merlin 2x2 Ribbed Cowl

Designed by Helen Firing for Estelle Designs

Difficulty Level: Advanced Beginner

Size and Finished Measurements: One size, to fit average adult Approximately 18" circumference (unstretched) by 16" deep

Materials:

2 100g/100m Estelle Yarns "Merlin" (shown in col 201), 1 24" 9mm/US size 13 needles, 1 stitch marker, yarn needle

Note: A smaller cowl can be achieved using one ball of "Merlin". Proceed according to the method below, knitting to a depth of approx. 8 ½" to leave enough yarn for casting off.

Gauge: 18 sts x 13 rows = 4 ins/10 cm unstretched, in pattern on 9mm/US size 13 needles

Method: Cast on 72 sts.

PM to indicate beg of round and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

Round 1: (K2, P2) to end of round.

Rep this round until work from beg measures approx 16".

Cast off loosely in rib.

Finishing: Weave in ends. Blocking is not required.
