## Merlin Squiggly Rib Hat

Designed by Helen Firing for Estelle Yarns

**Difficulty Level:** Advanced Beginner

**Size and Finished Measurements:**

One size, to fit small/medium adult head, Approximately 22" circumference by 8" deep (with brim folded up)

**Materials:** 2 100g/100m Estelle Yarns "Merlin" (shown in col 211), 1 pair 6.5mm/US size 10.5 needles  
1 pair 8mm/US size 11 needles

**Gauge:** 12 sts x 14rows = 4 ins/10 cm in pattern on 8mm/US size 11 needles

**Method:** With smaller needles cast on 67 sts. Work 16 rows garter st (knit every row) Change to larger needles and begin pattern as follows:

Row 1 (RS): (P3, K5) to last 3 sts, P3.

\*\*Row 2 (WS): K3, \*P5, K3; rep from \* to end.

Row 3 (RS): P3, (K1, (YO, K2tog) twice, P3, K5, P3) four times.

Rep rows 2 and 3 twice more.

Row 8 (WS): \*K3, P5; rep from \* to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 9 (RS): (P3, K5, P3, K1, (YO, K2tog) twice) four times, P3.

Rep rows 8 and 9 twice more.\*\*

Rep from \*\* to \*\* once more until work from beg measures approx. 9".

Decrease rows:

Row 1 (WS): \*K3, P5; rep from \* to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2 (RS): (P3, ssk, K3) 8 times to last 3 sts, P3 (59 sts).

Row 3 (WS): (K3, P2tog, P2) 8 times to last 3 sts, P3 (51 sts).

Row 4 (RS): (P3, K3tog) 8 times to last 3 sts, P3 (35 sts).

Row 5 (WS): (K3tog, P1) 8 times to last 3 sts, K3tog (17 sts).

Break yarn, leaving an approx. 4ft tail for sewing seam. Draw up rem 17 sts.

**Finishing:** Turn hat inside out and sew side seam down to garter st brim. Turn hat so right side is facing and finish sewing down garter st section so that hat may be turned up at brim.

## Merlin Squiggly Rib Scarf

**Difficulty Level:** Advanced Beginner

**Size and Finished Measurements:** One size, adult, approximately 66" long by 9" wide

**Materials:** 3 100g/100m Estelle Yarns "Merlin" (shown in col 211) 1 pair 8mm/US size 11 needles

**Gauge:** 12 sts x 14rows = 4 ins/10 cm in pattern on 8mm/US size 11 needles

**Method:** Cast on 27 sts.

Work 4 rows garter st (knit every row)

Row 1 (RS): K8, P3, K5, P3, K8.

\*\*Row 2 (WS): K3, \*P5, K3; rep from \* to end.

Row 3 (RS): K4, (YO, K2tog) twice, P3, K5, P3, K1, (YO, K2tog) twice, K3.

Rep rows 2 and 3 twice more.

Row 8 (WS): \*K3, P5; rep from \* to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 9 (RS): K8, P3, K1, (YO, K2tog) twice, P3, K8.

Rep rows 8 and 9 twice more.\*\*

Rep from \*\* to \*\* 20 times more until work measures approx. 63 1/2".

Work rows 2 and 3 three times more.

Work row 2 once more.

Beg with RS row, work 4 rows garter st (knit every row).

Cast off on RS and weave in all ends.

**Finishing:**

Wet block finished scarf by immersing in lukewarm water. Dry flat, pinning out side edges if necessary to prevent curling. When scarf is almost dry, place in mesh garment bag and finish drying in machine on warm.
