



FREE PATTERN





Morgana “Able to Cable” Cap Designed by Helen Firing for Estelle Yarns

Difficulty Level: Intermediate

Size and Finished Measurements: One size, to fit small/medium adult head - Approximately 18” circumference (unstretched) by 8” deep

Materials: 1 100g/100m Estelle Yarns “Morgana” (shown in col 102)

1 pair 6mm/US size 10 needles, 1 pair 6.5mm/US size 10.5 needles, Cable needle

Gauge: 18 sts x 18 rows = 4 ins/10 cm in 2 x 4 rib on 6mm/US size 10 needles

Special Stitches: **C4B** (cable 4 back): Slip 2 stitches purlwise onto a cable needle, and hold at the back of the work. Knit 2 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle.

C4F (cable 4 forward): Slip 2 stitches purlwise onto a cable needle, and hold at the front of the work. Knit 2 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle. **Method:** With smaller needles, cast on 86 sts. Row 1 (RS): (P2, K4) to last 2 sts, P2. Row 2 (WS): (K2, P4) to last 2 sts, K2. Rep rows 1 and 2 once more.

Row 5 (RS): (P2, C4B, P2, C4F) to last 2 sts, P2. Row 6 (WS): (K2, P4) to last 2 sts, K2. Row 7: (P2, K4) to last 2 sts, P2. Rep rows 6 and 7 once more. Row 10: (K2, P4) to last 2 sts, K2. Rep from * to * once more.

Change to larger needles and work from * to * until a total of 4 reps have been worked and work from beg measures approx. 6”. Work rows 5 and 6 once more.

Decrease rows: Row 1 (RS): (P2, K1, K2tog, K1) to last 2 sts, P2 (72 sts). Row 2 (WS): (K2, P3) to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 3: (P2, K2tog, K1) to last 2 sts, P2 (58 sts).

Row 4: (K2, P2) to last 2 sts, K2. Row 5: (P2tog, K2tog) to last 2 sts, P2tog (29 sts). Row 6: (K1, P1) to last st, K1.

Row 7: (K2tog) to last st, K1 (15 sts).

Row 8: P1, (P2tog) to end (8 sts).

Break yarn, leaving an approx. 36” for sewing up, and draw through rem 8 sts.

Finishing: Using cast off tail yarn, sew down side seam on WS from crown to cast on edge. Weave in ends.

Morgana “Able to Cable” Fingerless Mitts/Gauntlets Designed by Helen Firing for Estelle Yarns

Difficulty Level: Intermediate

Size and Finished Measurements: One size, adult, two lengths

Mitts: approximately 7” long by 6-6 ½” circumference (unstretched)

Gauntlets: approximately 13 ½” long by 6-6 ½” circumference (unstretched), additional materials and instructions shown in parentheses []

Materials: 1 [2]100g/100m Estelle Yarns “Morgana” (shown in col 102) 1 pair 6mm/US size 10 needles, [1 pair 6.5mm/US size 10.5 needles] Cable needle

Gauge: 18 sts x 18 rows = 4 ins/10 cm in 2 x 4 rib on 6mm/US size 10 needles

Special Stitches: **C4B** (cable 4 back): Slip 2 stitches purlwise onto a cable needle, and hold at the back of the work. Knit 2 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle.

C4F (cable 4 forward): Slip 2 stitches purlwise onto a cable needle, and hold at the front of the work. Knit 2 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle.

Method (make 2): Leave an approx. 12” tail for seaming later and with smaller needles, cast on 32 sts. Row 1 (RS): (P2, K4) to last 2 sts, P2. Row 2 (WS): (K2, P4) to last 2 sts, K2. Rep rows 1 and 2 once more. *Row 5 (RS): (P2, C4B, P2, C4F) twice, P2, C4B, P2. Row 6 (WS): (K2, P4) to last 2 sts, K2. Row 7: (P2, K4) to last 2 sts, P2. Rep rows 6 and 7 once more. Row 10: (K2, P4) to last 2 sts, K2.* Rep from * to * 3 times more.

[Change to larger needles and work from * to * until a total of 9 reps have been worked and work from beg measures approx. 13”] Rep rows 5 and 6 once. Working sts as for row 7, cast off loosely. Break yarn, leaving an approx. 24” [36”] tail for seaming.

Finishing (for both styles): Using 12” tail, fold in half lengthwise and sew side seam down 2” from cast on edge. Using longer tail at cast off edge, sew up side seam ending so that there is a 1 ½” gap left for thumb opening. Weave in ends.
