

FREE PATTERN



Herringbone Rib Scarf in Estelle Sakura
For hat please see Sakura Slouchy Hat Pattern
Designed by Kate Atherley for Estelle Yarns

Difficulty Level - Easy

Finished measurements:

6 inches wide, approx 60 inches long, after blocking

Materials:

1 skein (about 100 grams) Estelle Yarns “Sakura”

1 pair 5mm straight or circular needles

Gauge:

Approximately 18 sts and 16 rows = 4 inches square in pattern stitch; gauge is not critical for this project

Method:

Cast on 27 sts.

Rows 1 & 2: Knit.

Row 3: K1, [k1 wrapping yarn twice around needle, k1 wrapping yarn three times around needle, k1 wrapping yarn four times around needle, k1 wrapping yarn three times around needle, k1 wrapping yarn twice around needle, k5] three times, ending last repeat with k1 instead of k5.

Row 4: Knit, dropping extra wraps.

Rows 5 & 6: Knit.

Row 7: K6, [k1 wrapping yarn twice around needle, k1 wrapping yarn three times around needle, k1 wrapping yarn four times around needle, k1 wrapping yarn three times around needle, k1 wrapping yarn twice around needle, k5] twice, k1.

Row 8: Knit, dropping extra wraps.

Work until scarf is a little short of desired length, or you're nearly out of yarn, ending with a Row 1.

Cast off loosely. Tip: use a larger needle in your right hand on the cast off row to ensure an even and relaxed edge.

Finishing:

Wash and weave in ends.
